

Recycling Information

✓ Acceptable Items



Plastics

Recycle plastics #1, #2 and #5. Look on the bottom of containers for the number inside the recycling arrows.



Metal Cans

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans—steel, tin, bi-metal and aluminum.



Cardboard, Newspaper & Magazines

Recycle newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.



Paper Food Containers & Cartons

Recycle juice boxes, egg, ice cream and milk cartons, and cereal and pasta boxes.



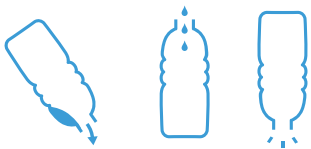
Paper

Recycle envelopes, office paper, junk mail, greeting cards and file folders. Shredded paper should be put in a paper bag.



Glass

Recycle clear, brown and green bottles and jars.



Empty. Clean. Dry.

Please make sure your recyclables are **empty, clean and dry** before placing them in your recycling cart.

Recycling Made Easy

- ✓ Please be sure your recycling cart is at the curb by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- ✓ All your recyclables can be placed together in the recycling cart. Place your cart 2 feet away from the street so it can easily be seen by the driver.

How to Recycle Properly

- ✓ All types of recyclables may be placed together in your recycling cart.
- ✓ If it looks like rain, be sure to close the cart lid. Wet paper products cannot be recycled.
- ✓ Rinse plastic, aluminum and metal cans; remove lids.

- ✗ Bubble wrap
- ✗ Christmas lights
- ✗ Coat hangers
- ✗ Electrical cords
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Food wrap
- ✗ Garden hoses
- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Polystyrene foam
- ✗ Rubber balls
- ✗ Sports equipment
- ✗ Stuffed animals
- ✗ Syringes/razor blades
- ✗ Waxed cartons
- ✗ Wood/yard waste
